

Charles William Gray of Corby bought a 25.2 horsepower Iris on 9th September 1920 at which time it was painted black, lined out in red and used as a public conveyance. It would appear that this vehicle was a large car rather than a commercial vehicle but Charles Gray quickly fitted a brown lorry body to the chassis of the Iris and equipped it with fourteen seats.

Presumably it was used only for private hires during the 1921 season and it enjoyed but a brief life, being withdrawn at the end of 1921 and having no further owner.
