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## MEADOWS, John & FROST, Harold Wilson & Walter Harry Kingsley Garage, Hallwood Road, KETTERING

This account continues the story of John Meadows of Burton Latimer after the time he joined forces with Harold Wilson Frost and Walter Harry Frost of Hallwood Road, Kettering in the latter half of 1924 when the partnership traded as both Meadows & Frost and M & F Motor Services. For details of John Meadows' earlier career readers are referred to paper NN-ME1. Very little of the Frost brothers earlier history has been uncovered save that the family came from Woodford and Harold Frost, in particular, was involved in a number of businesses during the course of his life and had his fingers in one or two bus operators' pies. It is clear that the Meadows and Frost families became friends and John Meadows' daughter Annie married Walter Frost in August 1925.

It seems that Meadows & Frost established a garage and office known as Kingsley Garage, Hallwood Road, Kettering, which became the firm's main operating base and repair shop, although buses continued to be parked at Regent House, Burton Latimer. Walter Frost was the mechanic and either at the same time as the formation of the partnership or shortly afterwards, a motor car sales and servicing garage was opened at the same location.

Meadows' original Burton Latimer - Kettering service was continued as were the irregular Wellingborough, Thrapston and Titchmarsh operations. In addition routes from Kettering to Corby via either Oakley or Weekley, Geddington, Stanion and Weldon were provided together with Kettering town services from Kingsley Avenue to Dalkeith Place and from Hallwood Road, operating past Timpson's Shoe Factory in Bath Road, to Dalkeith Place. Additionally, private hire and seaside services were operated with Great Yarmouth and Bournemouth being particularly popular destinations.


The timetables on pages 5 to 9 show the M & F services at 1st December 1929 and passengers travelling on these routes would have been issued with punch type tickets carrying the M&F title.

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#### MEADOWS & FROST - KETTERING

Meadows' six (2 Thornycroft, 2 Lancia and 2 W & G) vehicles were taken over by the partnership of Meadows & Frost in 1924. The joint operations were due to last for six years and during that time additional rolling stock of Lancia, REO, W & G and Chevrolet manufacture were acquired. Basically, one vehicle was added to the fleet each year until 1930 when five new or replacement buses were purchased. The Lancias were registered RP 796, RP 2194, RP 6014 and NR 5484 whilst the REOs took the marks RP 3809 and RP 9353. The W&G motor is recorded as RP 9322 whilst the Chevrolets, originally PW 9948/50/46 were re-registered RP 8342, RP 8383 and RP 8619 on acquisition by Meadows & Frost. Full details of the known fleet are listed at the end of this paper. Incidentally, Lancia NR 5484 came from E J Claypole of Corby (NN-CL8) when Meadows & Frost took over this operator's Corby to Kettering route circa September 1928.




This photograph shows a REO Pullman fitted with a twenty-seat Duple body which, after registration, became RP 3809. (Photo courtesy Commercial Motor).


Towards the end of the Meadows & Frost partnership a new service from Kettering to Huntingdon was developed, being routed via Barton Seagrave, Cranford, Thrapston, Bythorn, Spaldwick, Ellington and Brampton.

Above and below:- Two photographs of Lancia saloons operating in the Meadows & Frost fleet in the 1920s. The upper picture is probably BD 8270.




Whether Meadows & Frost could not agree on the future development of the firm is not known to the author but in the latter part of 1930 the joint arrangements were dissolved. It is clear that the Frost Brothers held by far the larger financial stake in the business as they retained the majority of the rolling stock, the garage premises and car retail business. The latter car retail operation may well have been entirely a Frost enterprise from the outset, in which Meadows had no share, but this has not been confirmed.

The Frosts formed a company called Frosts' (Motors) Ltd in November 1930 whilst John Meadows and his son Jim thereafter traded as J Meadows & Son. The stories of these operators are continued in accounts NN-FR5 and NN-ME3
