BASSFORD. Frank 9 St.George's Place NORTHAMPTON

Only the scantiest information has come to light regarding Frank Bassford of 9 St. George's Place, Northampton and that is that he bought a Ford T truck which was registered BD 4093 on 10th February 1920 and this was used as a public conveyance. This vehicle does not show up as a Hackney Carriage in surviving registration records that were commenced in 1921.

It is not thought that Frank Bassford was the same person listed in paper NN-BA10 and based at Welford, as Mrs Bassford was still shown as residing at St. George's Place in the 1928 Kelly" Directory.
