CHAPPELL Bros. 43 Edinburgh Road KETTERING

The Chappell Brothers were Haulage Contractors in the early post-First World War period, who in July 1920 advertised a motor vehicle for hire that seated thirty-two passengers. Nothing is known about this vehicle and it appears to have been advertised once only. Presumably the public showed little interest and the machine was undoubtedly henceforth used by Messrs Chappell Bros for haulage work.
