CRADDOCK. Thomas Obelisk House Mulso Square FINEDON

In Bennett's 1901 Business Directory of Northamptonshire Thomas Craddock is listed as a 'Bus Proprietor and in 1903 is elsewhere noted as providing a horsebus service in connection with the Midland Railway, running between Finedon Station and Mulso Square, Finedon. No doubt he was providing this service earlier than 1903 and Obelisk House was also described as an Omnibus Depot.

Furthermore Thomas Craddock was an Agent for the Midland Railway but he must have died prior to the 1911 Census as his wife, Emily, succeeded him as a Carting Agent for the Midland and is also mentioned in the 1914 Kelly's Directory of Northants.
