COLLINS. Frederick Herbert MORETON PINKNEY

Fred Collins was a Coal Merchant and Carrier operating from Moreton Pinkney to Banbury on Thursdays and to Northampton on Saturdays.

It would seem that Fred graduated to a motor bus in 1925 when on 25th March he purchased a fourteen-seater model T Ford which took the registration RP 690. In the absence of any definite information on what he used his bus for, one assumes that he continued his Thursday Banbury and Saturday Northampton services, carrying both passengers and parcels as required. No doubt RP 690 was available for private hires on the other days of the week.

Collins had ceased operating by the time the Road Traffic Act, 1930 was implemented.
