Booth Brothers of High Street, Brackley were principally haulage contractors who on 24th March 1926 took delivery of a Reo Speedwagon registered RP 2380, which was licensed as a Hackney Carriage. It is assumed that they hired out this vehicle to private parties and possibly continued to do so until the provisions of the 1930 Road Traffic Act may have led to the firm's abandonment of passenger vehicle operations. The Reo was subsequently sold to an Acton based Showman who used it for living quarters. The livery of the Speedwagon is thought to have been blue.
