## JONES. John Dennis 6A Midland Road WELLINGBOROUGH

All that is known of John Dennis Jones is that he bought a 35 horsepower Fiat lorry which was registered BD 3878 on 10th November 1919. Painted green, this Fiat was also licensed as a public conveyance and, presumably, was fitted with bench seats from time to time.

However, Jones kept BD 3878 for only four months, when the Fiat passed to Walter Whitmill of Moulton (paper NN-WH6) where it replaced a much older Daimler lorry/bus.
