

BOSWELL. Frank & Son 232 Mill Road WELLINGBOROUGH

Frank Boswell & Son were well known Wellingborough Haulage Contractors who probably never operated Public Service Vehicles. However, the firm is included in "Bygone Buses" as circa March 1935 it acquired a Reo Speed Wagon bus from William Rice of Wollaston. Registered RP 3700, this Reo was retained by Boswell & Son until being last licensed at the end of June 1938.

It is not believed that Boswell used it for carrying passengers but could have converted it into a lorry but, again, this is supposition.
