

## JEFCOATE. F H POTTERSPURY

All that is known of the above operator is that by 31st January 1921 and, more likely by the Autumn of 1919, he had purchased Ford T bus registered BD 3506. As far as can be discovered, he operated only private hires and did not provide any local bus services to either Northampton or to Stony Stratford and/or Wolverton.

Evidently Jefcoate operated BD 3506 for a year or two and it was at some stage licensed for both hackney and goods purposes. The Ford T was last owned by A F Cherry of Higham Ferrers and last licensed in July 1928.

An additional item of interest that may or may not be relevant to F H Jefcoate is that on 14th May 1919 a black 14 horsepower Star lorry registered A 1946 was transferred to a Harry Brown Jefcoate of Potterspury. This vehicle had originally been registered on 30th September 1909 with the re-issued number A 1946 and is not recorded as being licensed as a Hackney Carriage. No doubt F H and H B Jefcoate were related.
