The principal occupation of B H Miles of Newland Street, Kettering was that of a Fish Merchant. It is far from clear to the Author whether Miles actually operated his own vehicles, acted as an agent for Bagshaw & Sons, or did both.

This advertisement placed in September 1919 suggests Miles was running "Excelsior" and "Knight of the Road" on his own account and makes no reference to Bagshaw & Sons. This latter firm was, however, running to the same destinations at the same times and fares, and was advising potential passengers to book their seats at B H Miles premises in Newland Street. Neither "Excelsior" nor "Knight of the Road" are names known to have been used by Bagshaw & Sons.

In June 1921 the advertisement shown on the following page was placed in the Kettering Evening Telegraph by Bagshaw & Sons.

Although not a very clear reproduction, it will be noted that the advertisement says: "As previously advertised by B H Miles, Newland Street, Bagshaw's three new and up-to-date charabancs will run" etc.

Bagshaw's are not known to have acquired three new and up-to-date charabancs in June 1921. Were these vehicles really new or were they taken over from B H Miles? These questions cannot be answered at the present time. The same advertisement states that Bagshaw's could cater for parties from 19 to 85 passengers, indicating that they could have been running no more than four vehicles at that time.

B H Miles continued as an Agent for Bagshaw's until 1923 when the latter firm opened their own office in the yard of the Fleur De Lys Hotel in Newland Street, Kettering.
